

Glass Maintenance and Care Guide

The Big Rooflights are engineered as high-durability systems. Constructed using architectural-grade aluminium and high-specification glazing. To preserve the integrity of the glass and the powder-coated finish of the frames, regular maintenance is required.

Big Rooflights stipulates a minimum three-monthly cleaning interval for both the glass and aluminium components. Consistent adherence to this routine ensures the unit remains in pristine condition and prevents the accumulation of environmental contaminants that could compromise the finish over time.



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To maintain the performance and appearance of your rooflight, follow these cleaning protocols:

Standard Cleaning: Both the internal and external glass surfaces should be cleaned using a dedicated non-abrasive glass cleaner or a solution of mild detergent and warm water.

Approved Materials: Always use a soft cloth or non-abrasive sponge to prevent scratching the glass or damaging the specialized coatings.

Heavy Soiling: In the rare event of stubborn contaminants or heavy soiling, white spirit may be applied carefully to the affected area; however, abrasive scouring pads or caustic chemicals must never be used.

Internal Access & Safety: Due to the height and positioning of the internal glass, we strongly advise against DIY cleaning of the interior surface. It is recommended to hire a professional window cleaning contractor equipped with the specialized tools and safety gear required for high-level glazing.
